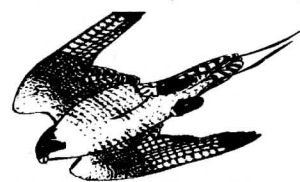


# Falcons Gymnastic Academy Club Competition. Thank you 2010
