

## Press Release – Byron Bags Bronze at Baskervilles

Byron Day-Rogers earned a magnificent Bronze Medal at the recent Baskervilles Cup as he made the ideal preparation for the upcoming Pegasus Open.

The Baskervilles Cup is an invitational competition where some of the best gymnasts across the south of England as far up as the Birmingham look to hone their skills against each other.

Byron, competing at the Under 12 National Code Level, Picked up his bronze medal thanks to a well executed, third best score of 12.80 on the Vault and second best score of 11.60 on the Parallel Bars. With an overall score of 63.30 Byron was able to just edge Falcons team-mate, Ryan Owen out of the Medals.

Ryan, despite securing a third best routine on High Bars – scoring 10.30 – was unable to emulate his usual high standard but with an overall score of 62.75 he was still able to place very highly amongst so many top standard gymnasts.

Earlier in the day George Feltham competing at 1999 level also secured a vault that was the third best in it's category with 12.45. George's Overall score of 67.55 saw him finish 6<sup>th</sup> on the day.

Elsewhere, three Falcons made the step up from the county scene to enter their first competition at this level.

Duncan Rendall and Jack Freeman, competing in the underage category, finished 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> respectively in what was ultimately a valuable learning experience as they look to step up their development for future events.

Finally, Archie Voss-Bark claimed 16<sup>th</sup> place in the 2001 category.
